FULL ADMISSION TO THE TEACHER EDUCATION UNIT

The Teacher Education Unit (TEU) program is comprised of professional level education courses numbered 3000 & above. Students accepted into the TEU professional level courses are designated Teacher Education Certification Candidates (TECC). **The following are the requirements for admission as TECC or to upper level education classes:**

- ◆ **Minimum GPA:** 3.0 GPA as mandated by Pennsylvania Act 354.
- ◆ **Assessment:** passing scores on Praxis I Certification Tests in Reading; Writing; & Mathematics. Visit www.ets.org or contact Career Development, 351 Hemlock Manor (570-662-4133) for information.
- ◆ **Coursework:** 6 credits of college level math, 3 credits of college level English composition & 3 credits of English Literature.
- ◆ **Clearances:** Act 34 Criminal Background check, Act 151 Child Abuse clearance, negative tuberculosis test, & fingerprint clearances for non-residents before doing class assignments in K-12 schools.
